The guest speaker is **Mr. Adib Bencherif**, who is a PhD student in Political Science at the University of Ottawa and doing his research about **terrorism in Sahel-Sahara region** at some institutions such as the Interdisciplinary Research Center on Africa and Middle East (CIRAM) of Laval University.
