The policies and practices of UN and other multilateral peace building missions and operations have developed substantially since the early 1990s. However, there has been increasing tension between the peace studies agendas and lesson-learned of policy and practitioner communities. Prof. Greene will critically examines those critiques and outline possible ways forward for international peace-buliding strategies with examples from Sub-Saharan Africa.
