Education (Media literacy)

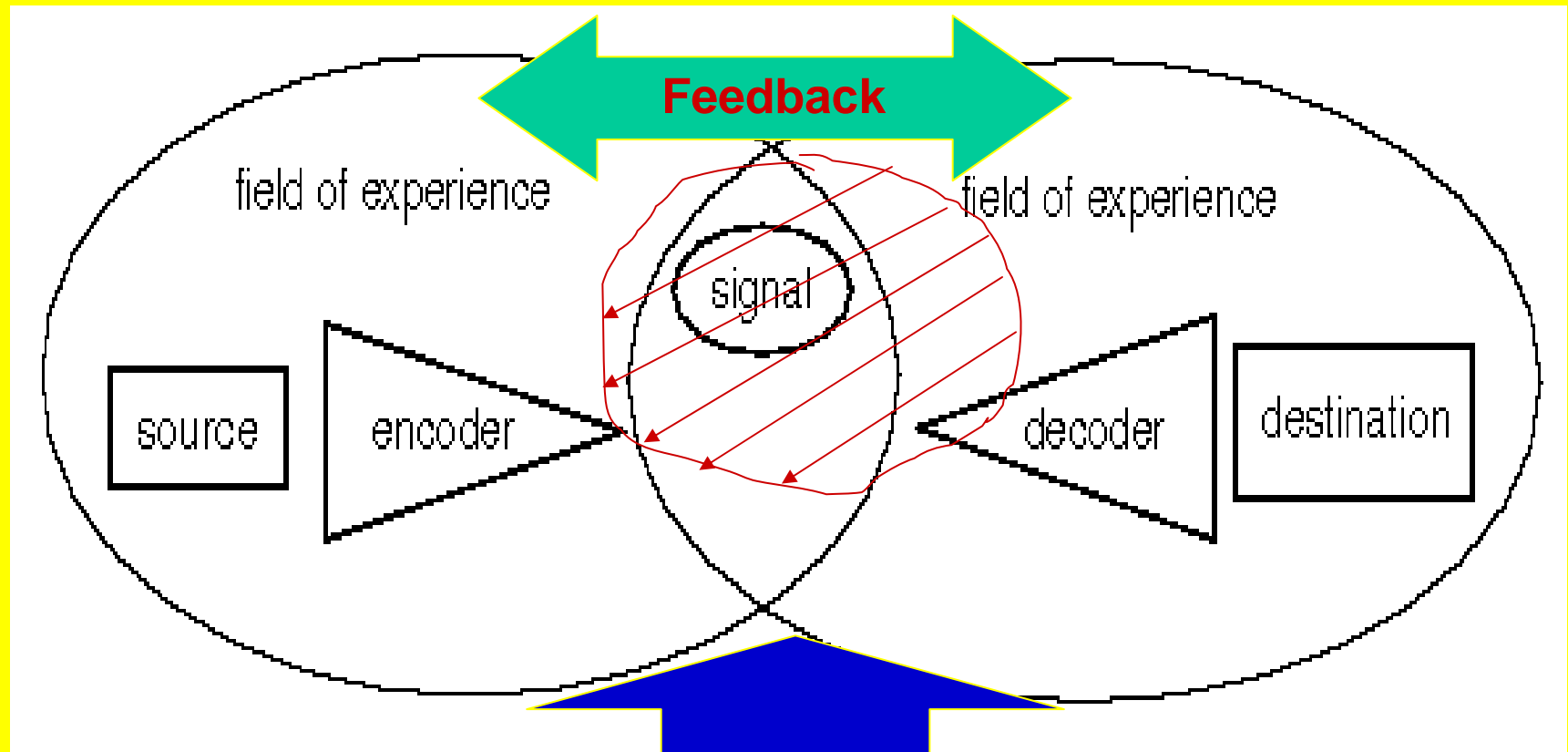
2. What are the roles of technologies/media in promoting communication?

**Media/Technologies:
A channel of communication**

As a channel of communication, Media/Technologies can help:

**1) Improve understanding
facts and issues involved**

2) Promote two way communications

3) Enhance collaboration

1) Improve understanding facts and issues

2) Promote two-way communications

Example:

Face-to-face meetings

Asynchronous - Emails, Blogs, BBS, SMS

**Synchronous – Video conferencing, Skype,
Messenger**

Podcasting:

Official Definition: A Web-based audio broadcast via an RSS feed, accessed by subscription over the Internet.

Easier To Understand: An audio file which you can download and listen to.
