Content of job information	<p>The M.A. program in Peace and Conflict Studies (PCS) at Graduate School of Global Studies, Tokyo University of Foreign Studies, invites applications for an adjunct teaching position in Peace and Conflict Studies for the academic year 2020-2021 (Spring or Fall Term). The language of instruction is English. A Ph.D degree in development economics, preferably from universities in English-speaking countries, and an experience in teaching university classes in English, preferably at a graduate-school level, are required.</p> <p>The Peace and Conflict Studies (PCS) Program at Tokyo University of Foreign Studies is an interdisciplinary educational program launched in 2004. It aims to fulfill the recognized need in many parts of the world for professionals with expertise in peace and conflict, violence, peacebuilding, and other related global and transnational issues. Each year the program admits a small but diverse group of individuals selected from among applicants coming from war-torn and/or conflict-laden developing countries and provides them with unique opportunities to learn critical approaches to the issues of utmost importance to them. All courses are held in English.</p> <p>We are seeking an experienced instructor for an elective course focused on the economic dimensions (i.e., causes, consequences, and challenges) of conflict (of various types) and post-conflict development largely in the context of developing countries.</p>
