1. Position: One full-time faculty staff.

2. Affiliation and place of work: Research Institute for Languages and Cultures of Asia and Africa (ILCAA)

3. Job description: Research on Asia (excluding Japan) and/or Africa

4. Rank:

Assistant professor with a five-year limited term appointment. (Note that this is a tenure-track position. The appointee will be eligible to apply for a tenured associate professor position after three years of service.)

5. Qualifications:

- a) Applicants must specialize in descriptive research on individual languages in Asia (excluding Japan) and/or Africa, particularly in quantitative or statistical research on phonetics and phonology, and should meet the aims of the ILCAA core project "Description and Documentation of Language Dynamics in Asia and Africa: Toward a More In-depth Understanding of the Languages and Cultures of People Living in Asia and Africa (DDDLing)".
- b) Applicants must have already received a doctorate degree or have done so by the date of appointment.
- c) Applicants must be able to demonstrate that their research has strong connections to Asia (excluding Japan) and Africa.
- d) Applicants must have the ability to promote the core research activities of ILCAA.
- e) Applicants must be able to demonstrate the ability to plan and lead creative and cutting-edge joint research projects.

6. Start date: April 1, 2024.

The appointment may, however, be deferred to a later date if there are reasonable grounds for requesting this.

7. Treatment :

a) Salary

Annual salary system (the annual salary amount is based on work experience, performance, and other factors, and the annual salary amount divided by twelve months is paid monthly). Tax and co-payment of social insurance premiums (employment insurance premiums and mutual aid association premiums) shall be deducted.

b) Work style

Discretionary Labor System for Professional Work (equivalent to 38 hours 45 minutes per week, 7 hours 45 minutes per day)

c) Holidays and leave

In accordance with the Employee Working Hours and Leave Regulations of Tokyo University of Foreign Studies.

8. Documents required for application:

* All application documents must be submitted in PDF form.

- a) A cover letter specifying "Linguistics." Contact information, including postal and email addresses, should also be provided in the cover letter.
- b) A CV with an ID photograph attached. Information regarding languages that the applicant can use in conducting research should be included in the CV.
- c) Document(s) showing the successful completion of a doctorate or indicating that a doctoral thesis

has been submitted (Submit this only if applicable.).

- d) A statement outlining the applicant's research career (A4 paper size, horizontal writing, no more than 4,000 characters in Japanese or 1,600 words in English). In the statement, applicants should indicate if they have previous affiliations with academic institutions in Asia (excluding Japan) and/or Africa, as well as research institutions which focus on research on these areas, or have participated in joint research with ILCAA.
- e) A research proposal (A4 paper size, horizontal writing, no more than 4,000 characters in Japanese or 1,600 words in English). The statement should include two plans:
 - 1) A plan of the joint research that the applicant would organize at ILCAA.
 - 2) A plan of research activities that the applicant would begin in the ILCAA core project "Description and Documentation of Language Dynamics in Asia and Africa: Toward a More In-depth Understanding of the Languages and Cultures of People Living in Asia and Africa (DDDLing)"

- f) Publications:
 - 1) A complete list of publications.
 - 2) A PDF copy of three selected works (including book chapters) that applicants have already published.
- g) The name, affiliation, and contact information of two researchers who can provide references.

9. Selection process:

After an initial screening of the application documents, shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview, in person, at ILCAA. The interview date is scheduled for Sunday, July 23, 2023. Candidates selected for the interview will be contacted by mid-July. We regret that travel expenses for the interview cannot be reimbursed.

* If the COVID-19 situation does not allow the applicants to travel to ILCAA, the interview will be conducted online.

11. Application procedure:

a) Applicants must initially contact jinji-aa@tufs.ac.jp by email; the subject line should read

"Application (Linguistics)." The deadline for applications is 23:59 (JST), Wednesday, May 17, 2023.

- b) Applicants will receive an email from ILCAA with a link to the website for the submission of the application documents. If applicants do not receive it within three days (excluding Saturday, Sunday, and public holidays), they should contact <u>jinji-aa@tufs.ac.jp</u>.
- c) Applicants must create PDF files of all application documents (with the applicant's name included in the filenames) and upload them to the specified URL. The deadline for uploading the application documents is 23:59 (JST), Wednesday, May 31, 2023.
- d) After uploading, applicants will be sent an email confirming the receipt of the documents by ILCAA. If they do not receive the confirmation email within a week, they should contact jinji-aa@tufs.ac.jp.
