

# Online Japanese Course with On-Demand Learning Materials

In this course, you will learn Japanese language in 14 weeks using JPLANG on-demand learning materials. Choose the level that is right for you from two levels ranging from Elementary1 to Elementary2. You can learn Japanese by practicing conversations and drills with audio, by reading grammar explanations translated into 15 languages, and more. Weekly quizzes and assignments will be given, and there is a live lesson once in a month, focusing on speaking activities, where you can check your command of Japanese language and learning outcomes. Come study Japanese with other Japanese language learners from around the world, and enjoy learning the language at your own pace!

#### Course Details

- This course is designed for the learners who can:
  - > Self-study using the on-Demand learning materials
  - Access JPLANG and connect to the Internet for the live lessons
  - > Attend once-a-month live online lessons all four times
  - > Read hiragana and katakana without difficulty

  - > Elementary-level sentence patterns through studying "Grammar" and "Drills"
  - Practical use of sentence patterns through studying "Conversation Practice" and "Listening"
  - Ability to speak coherently on a topic through the final assignment
- Live Online Lesson: Total of 4 lessons (1st, 6th, 11th, and 15th week)

Based on the contents of the on-demand learning materials, lessons will focus on "speaking" such as conversation and presentation.

The final assignment will be presented in the live online lesson in the 15th week.
