Japanese Pre-Intermediate 2

Course Content

Japanese Pre-Intermediate 2 is for those who have been studying at the pre-intermediate level for a short period of time. The goal of this course is to acquire pre-intermediate Japanese skills mainly through conversation practice. Course students will continue with the same textbook used in Pre-Intermediate 1 to study words, grammar and conversational expressions. By the end of the course, students will be able to express in Japanese their experiences and impressions, as well as make oral presentations in Japanese using pictures and photos.

Pre-Intermediate 2 is for those who have studied at a pre-intermediate level for a short period of time, and designed for those who are able to:

- Talk about rules of your country.
- Describe food and dishes from your country.
- Talk about what kind of person you want to be in future.
- Talk about your future plan.

These are some of the content which you will learn in Pre-Intermediate 2.

- Ask your classmates about souvenirs from their country, where to stay when visiting and what food they recommend.
- Talk about things you've noticed recently that you think is surprising or makes you happy.
- Use the passive to talk about problem you've had.
- Talk about what you would let/make your children learn when you become a parent. (Causative form)
