Course Content

Japanese Intermediate 1 is for those who have completed the pre-intermediate level of study. In addition to the study of words, grammar, and conversational expressions, course students will acquire an intermediate level of Japanese language skills through the study of social and cultural themes. By the end of the course, students will be able to express their own opinions and explain their reasons in Japanese. Students will also be able to make presentations in Japanese on their research and thoughts using slides.
