# **Preparing for Online Classes**

### 1. Preparing a system environment

The following equipment / environment is required to take online classes offered by Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (TUFS). TUFS does not provide Wi-Fi access or digital devices.

- Digital device such as a PC or tablet with internet connection
- Microphone
- Webcam
- Speakers, earphones or headphones
- 1) Digital device (any one of the following)
  - Desktop PC
  - Laptop PC
  - Tablet device

# [NOTE]

- \*1: It is recommended that you use a PC or tablet when taking an online course, as it is difficult to view documents or submit reports with a smartphone.
- \*2: You need to access to the website for PC browsers to submit your report or assignments.
- 2) Webcam (any one of the following)
  - PC with a built-in camera
  - External camera
  - Mobile devices with a built-in camera

\*When attending an online class, you will need to turn your camera on and your microphone off.

- 3) Microphone (any one of the following)
  - PC with a built-in microphone
  - USB headset with a microphone
  - Plug-in-type headphones
- 4) Speakers, earphones or headphones (any one of the following)
  - PC with built-in speakers
  - External speakers
  - Earphones or headphones

\*Headphones with a microphone delivers excellent audio and are best suited for taking an online class.

#### 5) Internet access

You will need access to the Internet to take an online class. It is important to have a stable Internet connection because the online classes will consume a lot of data. Hence, we recommend that you use a LAN cable connection which is more stable than Wi-Fi.

\*TUFS will not be responsible for any difficulties or disadvantages caused by bad Internet connection on your side.

#### 2. Install Zoom

Installation of Zoom (an application for video conference) is required before taking an online class.

#### On a PC

- Access the Zoom website. https://zoom.us/download#client\_4meeting
- 2. Click [Client for meeting] and start downloading.
- 3. After that, click [ZoomInstaller.exe] and install the Zoom application.
- 4. Installation completed.

# On a Tablet

- For iPad, install from the App Store and for an Android tablet, install from Google Play: (Zoom Cloud Meeting)
- 2. Installation completed.

# 3. Logging in and setting up Google Classroom for contact, downloading documents, and submitting reports

# 1) Your Google account

You will need a Google account, to access Google Classroom. If you do not already have a Google account, please make one.

- Your Gmail address will be shared with your professor. If you prefer, please make a separate Google account for that.
- Please note, we do not provide technical support for online classes.

#### 2) Logging into Google Classroom

Use your Google account to log into Google Classroom.

- You will need to access to the Internet to log in.
- You must use your own Google account, not an account belonging to a family member or someone else. This is because we will need to identify you with your account.
- The first time to log in.
  - Access the URL below and click [Classroom].

  - 2. Enter your username and click [Next].
  - 3. Enter your password and click [Next].
  - 4. After the welcome message appears on the screen, check the contents and click [Agree].

#### 3) Entering the classroom

- TUFS will send your class code via email.
  - 1. Log in to Google Classroom.
  - 2. Click [+] at the top of the page and click [attend].
  - 3. Enter your class code that appears in the pop-up window and click [Attend] to complete the registration.
- You are properly registered to your class if you can access to your classroom (Note: Your name will not appear in the list of students in your

class.)

- Students are not allowed to access to email addresses of their classmates and teacher.
- Please note that TUFS does not provide technical support for online classes.
