

Sustainability of Regional Societies

At the Guidance for "Sustainability of Regional Societies" (held on-line as summer intensive), we will cover the details of the study plan and how to register.

The goals of the course is to recognize the contemporary problems the Japanese regional societies are facing and to search for effective measures through communicating with the local people, and come up with specific plans to revitalize the regions by collaborating with the local municipalities and industries.

During the class,

- (1) One will learn how the municipalities reacted and responded to the covid-19 pandemic. Participating municipalities are; Yamagata pref., Sagae-shi, Takahata-machi, Shirataka-machi and Iide-machi.
- (2) JETRO will give us a lecture on issues relative to overseas expansion and telework
- (3) TUFS Students will share what they discovered about Yamagata with the local student, and local students will share the challenges they are facing. Through such exchange, both with tackle together on the necessary measures to be taken to solve the issues
- (4) We will invite the past participants and the local people to go over the proposed plans of the past participants, how it has been installed and its outcome and come up with new proposals.
