

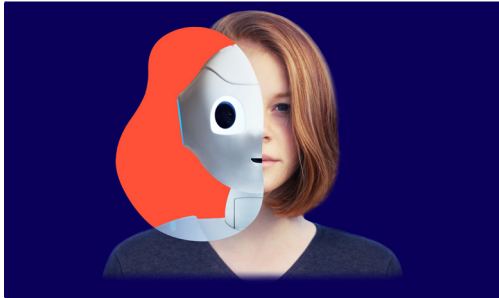
ST.GALLEN SYMPOSIUM

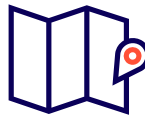
Trust Matters

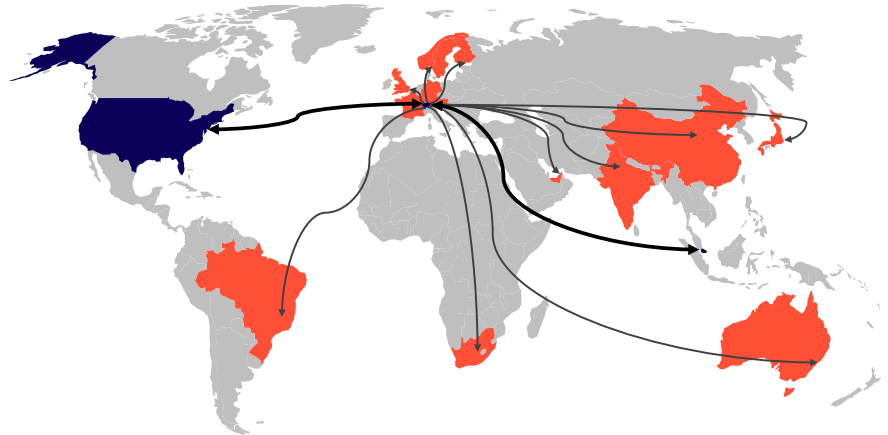
