## Call for Papers

The Consortium for Asian and African Studies [CAAS] will hold its 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Symposium at Hankuk University of Foreign Studies via ZOOM, on Wednesday and Thursday, October 26-27, 2022. Graduate students and faculty of the seven CAAS member universities (Leiden, INALCO, SOAS, HUFS, Columbia, TUFS, SISU) are invited to submit proposals for papers.

## Symposium Theme

Many countries around the world, despite the initial shock of the Covid-19 pandemic, have shown significant resilience, bouncing back faster than expected. However, individual nations and organizations are encountering difficulties in coping with the recovery due to inflations, supply chain disruptions, and workforce unavailability. Given the rapidly changing domestic and international circumstances in the post-pandemic world, the proposed theme of the 2022 CAAS Symposium held at HUFS is '**Resilience: Recovery in the Post-Pandemic World**'. Resilience comes in many forms and will likely become a higher strategic priority for the public and private sectors alike. The symposium will explore how various stakeholders of society recognize and instill resilience at local, national, and international levels in the context of the African and Asian regions. We welcome papers from a wide variety of interdisciplinary and theoretical perspectives that could provide insights and a better understanding of how resilience in the post-Covid world could be achieved.

Papers will be selected based on content and approach, potential for exchange among the participants, and benefits, including a broad range of topics and disciplines. The papers will be grouped by themes into panels, which will be conducted as workshops, with 15-minute presentations by speakers, 10-minute remarks by commentators.

### **Submission**

Papers submitted to the organizers by September 23 will be made available to the audience at the Symposium. English is the language of the Symposium, and as in the past four CAAS Symposia, we especially welcome applications from graduate students and post-docs as well as from faculty members.

### **Submit a Symposium Proposal:**

- 1) A one-page abstract describing the topic and approach of the paper
- 2) A one-page curriculum vitae.

Proposals should be combined into a single PDF document, which should be sent as an e-mail attachment to **caas\_hufs2022@hufs.ac.kr**,
