Consortium for Asian and African Studies (CAAS) The 3rd International Conference at SOAS

アジア・アフリカ研究・教育コンソーシアム (CAAS) 第3回国際シンポジウムを開催(於:ロンドン大学東洋・アフリカ研究学院)

From February 16 to 18, 2012, for the duration of 3days, SOAS hosted the 3rd international symposium organized by "The Consortium for Asian and African Studies (CAAS)." CAAS is comprised of 7 institutions, including TUFS that are at a worldwide top level of conducting Asian and African research and education.

This symposium was held, following the first symposium hosted by Leiden University of the Netherlands in 2009 and the second symposium hosted by INALCO of France in 2010. Each institution of CAAS is going to host an annual symposium in turn.

2012年2月16日から18日の3日間、本学をはじめアジア・アフリカ研究で世界のトップレベルにある7機関が構成する国際的コンソーシアム「アジア・アフリカ研究・教育コンソーシアム」(CAAS)主催による第3回国際シンポジウムがロンドン大学東洋・アフリカ研究学院(SOAS)を会場にして開催されました。

本シンポジウムは、一昨年ライデン大学(オランダ)で行われた第1回シンポジウム、昨年フランス 国立東洋言語文化学院(INALCO)で行われた第2 During the symposium, 41 researchers from CAAS institutions (Institut National des Langues et Civilisations Orientales, Leiden University, The Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences of National University of Singapore(FASS-NUS), The School of Oriental and African Studies of University of London, Columbia University, Hankuk University of Foreign Studies and TUFS) made presentations regarding their research, based on the theme of "Making a Difference – Representing/ Constructing the Other in Asian/ African Media, Cinema and Languages." From TUFS, two senior researchers and five young researchers who conducted research at the CAAS affiliated schools under the JSPS international training programs, presented their research.

For those young researchers who attended the symposium, it was a great opportunity to have experiences through presenting their research at an international symposium and to meet other top level researchers from all over the world.

The symposium was held with assistance from "International Training Program (ITP)" of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science(JSPS).

今回のシンポジウムでは、"Making a Difference - Representing/ Constructing the Other in Asian/ African Media, Cinema and Languages "をテーマに、CAAS に加盟する INALCO、ライデン大学、シンガポール国立大学、SOAS、コロンビア大学、韓国外国語大学校及び本学から総勢 41 名の研究者が発表を行いました。本学からは2名の教員と、本学で採択されている日本学術振興会の事業を利用して CAAS 加盟機関等で研究を行った経験を持つ、5名の若手研究者が発表を行いました。

参加した若手研究者にとっては、国際シンポジウム で研究発表を行うことで大きな経験を得るとともに、 世界で先端的研究を行う研究者や各国の若手研究者 と研究交流を行う貴重な機会となりました。

なお、本シンポジウムは独立行政法人日本学術振興会の「若手研究者インターナショナル・トレーニング・プログラム(ITP)」による支援を得て開催したものです。

Introduction

Prof. Miyazaki, CAAS executive coordinator announced the opening of the meeting with all the representatives of member institutions.

Nomination of the chairperson

Prof. Rao was elected the chairperson from among the attended members.

Reporting items

Prof. Miyazaki introduced the new CAAS member, Hankuk University of Foreign Studies (HUFS) and the coordinator Prof. Jang.

Prof. Jang made a brief introduction to HUFS.

Prof. Miyazaki reported that all the coordinator had approved the Minutes of the 3rd CAAS Coordinators in Paris. Prof. Miyazaki showed new leaflet of CAAS, which was published by TUFS and included HUFS as member.

Agenda

1. Extension of CAAS Agreement

The CAAS agreement will terminate on 6th March, 2012. Prof. Miyazaki proposed the extension of the agreement and its procedure, and showed a draft of "Agreement extension of Consortium for Asian and African Studies." All the member institution agreed the extension and its procedure. TUFS will send two copies "Agreement extension" signed by CAAS executive coordinator to each

開会

CAAS エグゼクティブ・コーディネーター宮崎教授より、全加盟機関からの代表の出席により、会議を開催する旨、アナウンスがあった。

議長の選出

互選により、Rao 教授が指名された。

報告事項

宮崎教授より、新規 CAAS メンバーの韓国外国語 大学校及びそのコーディネーターである Jang 教授の 紹介があった。Jang 教授は韓国外国語大学校の紹介 を行った。

宮崎教授が前回コーディネーター会議の議事録が すでに了承を得たことを報告し、さらに、韓国外国語 大学校を含む新しい CAAS リーフレットの作成報告 をした。

議題

1. CAAS 協定の延長について

2012年3月6日で失効する CAAS 協定について、 宮崎教授が協定の延長ならびに延長方法を提案し、 協定延長のための文書案を提示した。全機関がこの 提案を了承した。CAASエグゼクティブ・コーディネー ターが署名した文書を2部各機関におくり、各機関 の代表者がこれに署名したのち、1部を東京外国語 member institution and the member institution signed for two copies and send the one copy back to TUFS.

2. Provisional Schedule of CAAS Symposium and Workshop after 2012

Prof. Goh explained NUS plan for next CAAS Symposium. He proposed "Sustainable Cities" as the symposium theme and 20–22 February 2013 as the date. Due to the funding problem and the university schedule, a few institutions asked NUS to consider a little earlier date for the symposium. Also, a few institutions asked NUS to consider a little wider theme like "representations of urban culture". Prof. Goh promised to consider these two points again, and to change them if possible.

The meeting confirmed further schedule of the symposia: Columbia University in 2013–14 and HUFS 2014–15. Prof. Barnett told that Columbia University would welcome any suggestions on the theme of the symposium.

3. Publishing the proceedings of the 3rd CAAS Symposium (SOAS)

Prof. Miyazaki explained that TUFS needed to publish the proceedings of the symposium, especially, articles of graduate students, and had a budget for it. On the other hands, Prof. Kirsch had a plan to publish a book including about 10 articles from the symposium, from a leading publisher. After discussions, the procedure had determined. First, CAAS will collect papers for publication. Among the collected papers, ten most suitable papers will be selected for the book publication. SOAS, Columbia University, INALCO and TUFS will engage in the selection. Those articles that are not selected will be published in TUFS publication and/or in the CAAS web site with the approval of the authors.

4. Potential new CAAS member institutions

Prof. Miyazaki explained the policy and procedure for inviting a new CAAS member. University of Naples – L'Oirentale, University of Vienna, University of Dakar, Australian National University and a university in South Africa were mentioned as the potential new members. The member institutions agreed to keep the policy and procedure.

5. CAAS funding situation

Prof. Miyazaki explained that the Institutional Program for Young Researcher Overseas Visits funded by Japan Society for the Promotion of Science would terminate on 14 February 2013. He asked the member institutions to continue their efforts to apply funds for CAAS activities.

2012 年以降の CAAS シンポジウム・ワークショップ開催予定について

Goh 教授が、次回 NUS で開催予定の CAAS シンポジウム・ワークショップの説明を行った。テーマは「持続可能な都市」、日程は 2013 年 2月 20 - 22日を予定している。派遣費用及び学年歴の関係から、開催を少し早くして欲しいという要望があり、また、テーマに関しても、「都市文化の表象」のようなより広いものにして欲しいという要望があった。Goh 教授が早急に再検討することを確約した。

今後のスケジュールとして 2013 - 14 年にコロンビア大学、2014 - 15 年に韓国外国語大学校で開催されることが確認された。Barnett 教授は、コロンビア大学はテーマに関してあらゆる意見・提案を受け付けていると述べた。

3. 第3回 CAAS シンポジウム・ワークショップ報告 書の出版について

宮崎教授より、東京外国語大学としては第1回、第2回同様、第3回 CAAS シンポジウムについても、報告書の作成を行う必要があることの説明があった。一方で SOAS の Kirsch 教授は 10 本ほどの論文からなる本格的な論文集を有名出版社から出版する計画があることを報告した。審議の結果、方針が策定された。CAAS として論文を募集し、特に出版社から出版するに相応しい 10 本程度の論文を選考する。SOAS、コロンビア大学、INALCO、東京外国語大学が選考にあたる。選考されなかった残りの論文は、執筆者の希望に応じて、東京外国語大学の出版する報告書、および CAAS ウェッブサイトに掲載することが決定した。

4. CAAS 新規メンバーについて

宮崎教授が CAAS の新規メンバーを加える方針と手続きについて説明した。ナポリ東洋大学、ウィーン大学、ダカール大学、オーストラリア国立大学、南アフリカの大学などが候補として挙がった。全機関がこれまでの方針と手続きを遵守することで合意した。

5. CAAS 資金状況について

宮崎教授より、2013年2月14日に日本学術振興会の短期派遣プログラムが終了することについて説明があった。加盟機関、それぞれが資金獲得に努力するよう要請があった。

6. Cooperative research projects among CAAS member institutions

Prof. Miyazaki reported on an ad hoc CAAS symposium, "New Prospects for Foreign Language Teaching in Higher Education", which held on March 2-3, 2011 at TUFS. In addition, he expressed his gratitude to the member institutions that joined pair reviews of Global COE Program of TUFS.

Closing

Prof. Rao gave a closing remark.

6. CAAS 加盟機関間の共同研究プロジェクトについ て

Launching of East Asia Foreign Studies University Consortium

東アジア圏外国語大学コンソーシアム発足

East Asia Foreign Studies University Consortium Agreement

Objective

The foreign studies universities in East Asia that have signed here recognize the importance of foreign language education and area studies on the basis of foreign languages in accordance with the rapid globalization of society, and agree to form a consortium to cooperate in developing human resources that contribute to the global sphere.

Projects

The Consortium member institutions (hereinafter referred to as "Member Institutions") shall work together closely to achieve the objective of the Consortium and accomplish the following projects:

- (1) Formulation and implementation of collaborative educational programs
- (2) Implementation of common foreign language education
- (3) Exchange of faculty members for exchange professorships etc.
- (4) Joint evaluations for quality assurance related to foreign language education
- (5) Implementation of credit transfer
- (6) Conferences related to methods for global human resource development
- (7) Other matters agreed between Member Institutions

Environmental Improvements

In order to smoothly accomplish the objective of the Consortium, Member Institutions shall constantly improve the environment as follows:

- Appointment of coordinators: Member Institutions shall each appoint coordinators etc. for smooth management of the Consortium.
- (2) Steering Committee: A Steering Committee shall be established by the Coordinators and related staff in order to accomplish the objectives of the Consortium along with periodic follow-ups.

- (3) Waiving of tuition fees etc.: Examination fees, entrance fees and tuition fees relating to credit transfers between Member Institutions shall be mutually waived.
- (4) Dissemination of information: In order to sustain the project quality in accordance with the objectives of the Consortium, there shall be a constant dissemination of information related to the projects of the Consortium from the perspective which is conducive to the appropriate judgment and selection of participating students for the projects.
- (5) Member Institutions shall mutually provide the necessary conveniences in order to accomplish the objectives of the Consortium.

Effectiveness of the Consortium Agreement etc.

- (1) This Agreement shall come into effect on the date signed by the representatives of the Member Institutions and will be valid for five years thereafter. Furthermore, the term of validity can be renewed based on the agreement of all Member Institutions.
- (2) The consent of all Member Institutions is required to add a new Member Institution.
- (3) Member Institutions shall withdraw by giving at least six months' notice.
- (4) This Agreement shall be revised with the agreement of all Member Institutions.
- (5) Member Institutions shall enter into separate memorandum etc. as necessary in order to accomplish the objectives of the Consortium.

This agreement is made in English as the mutually agreed official language. Three copies of this agreement are made and signed in original by three Member Institutions.

Establishment of Agreements for Exchanges with Beijing Foreign Studies University


北京外国語大学と交流協定を締結

On November 14, 2011, Vice President JIN Li and 3 others from Beijing Foreign Studies University visited TUFS' President Kameyama to establish agreements for exchanges between Beijing Foreign Studies University and TUFS.

Beijing Foreign Studies University centralizes around research and education in the 49 languages of the world, but also holds School of Asian and African Studies, School of International Business, and School of International Relations and Diplomacy. It is a comprehensive university for the humanities, and holds a history of cultivating many diplomats. TUFS and Beijing Foreign Studies University already engage in exchanges of students and faculty in the Polish Major, and in the education and research of the Japanese language. However, on this occasion, the two universities agreed to make further use of their characteristics of specializing in foreign languages, by engaging in exchanges between students majoring in Chinese, and by deepening their systematic exchanges.
