## **Regulations Concerning the Implementation of the Dual Degree Program Between Tokyo University of Foreign Studies and Rio de Janeiro State University**

( June 24, 2025  
Regulation No. 43 )

### **Article 1            Purpose**

These Regulations shall provide for necessary matters relating to the Dual Degree Program (hereinafter referred to as “DDP”) to be implemented between the School of Language and Culture Studies and the School of Japan Studies of Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (hereinafter referred to as the “University”) and the Institute of Letters of Rio de Janeiro State University (hereinafter referred to as “UERJ”) under the agreement executed between the University and UERJ.

### **Article 2            DDP**

- 1    DDP means a program in which a student enrolled in the School of Language and Culture Studies Portuguese Language Department of the University (hereinafter referred to as “University Student”) is admitted to the Institute of Letters of UERJ while enrolled in the University or a student enrolled in the Institute of Letters of UERJ (hereinafter referred to as “UERJ Student”) is admitted to the School of Japan Studies of the University while enrolled in UERJ, acquires the credits prescribed by the University and UERJ, and is awarded the degree specified by each the University and UERJ.
- 2    UERJ Students participating in the DDP will be enrolled as Third-year Transfer Students to the University’s School of Japan Studies.

### **Article 3            Study Abroad by University DDP Student and Accreditation**

- 1    The period of study abroad of the University Students participating in the DDP (hereinafter referred to as “University DDP Student”) shall be two (2) years, in principle. However, this shall not apply if it is found that there are particular circumstances.
- 2    University DDP Students shall take fifty-two (52) credits or above from the compulsory courses and the elective courses set forth in the Appended Table to be offered by the Institute of Letters of UERJ and shall acquire ninety-six (96) credits or above in total.
- 3    Credits earned by University DDP Students in the Institute of Letters of UERJ shall be recognized as credits for the School of Language and Culture Studies of the University in each of the course categories listed in the Appended Table.
- 4    The Guidelines for Overseas Study of Undergraduate Schools of Tokyo University of Foreign Studies shall apply mutatis mutandis to the procedures, etc. for the accreditation of credits.

Article 4            UERJ Graduation Requirements

The requirements for University DDP Students to graduate UERJ shall be in accordance with the regulations, etc. established by UERJ.

Article 5            Miscellaneous Provisions

Any matters not set forth in these Regulations shall be prescribed separately.

Supplementary Provisions

These Regulations shall be effective as of July 1, 2025
