Regulations Concerning the Courses Offered at the Graduate School of Global Studies of Tokyo University of Foreign Studies, the Number of Credits Assigned to Each Course, and the Registration Procedures for the Courses Offered

Article 1 Purpose

These Regulations provide for necessary matters relating to the courses offered and the number of credits assigned to each course at the Graduate School of Global Studies (hereinafter referred to as the “Graduate School”) in accordance with Article 26 of the Graduate School Regulations of Tokyo University of Foreign Studies Graduate School (hereinafter referred to as the “Graduate School Regulations”) and the registration procedures for the Master’s Program and Doctoral Program of the Graduate School in accordance with Article 28 of the Graduate School Regulations.

Article 2 Courses Offered and Number of Credits in the Master’s Program of the Graduate School

The courses offered and the number of credits assigned to each course in the Master’s Program of the Graduate School shall be as listed in Appendices 1 through 7.

Article 3 Number of Credits Required to Complete the Master’s Program

1 The registration procedures for the Master’s Program of the Graduate School prescribed in Article 28 of the Graduate School Regulations shall be as follows. Students shall acquire the prescribed number of credits and receive research guidance.

- 2 Of the courses listed in the items of the preceding paragraph, the following courses shall be taken in the following manner:
- (1) Students shall complete Fundamentals of Global Studies and Cross-Disciplinary Seminar in the year of admission in principle;
 - (2) Students shall complete, as research guidance, Master's Thesis and Research Seminar administered by their main academic supervisors in the year in which such students write a master's thesis and shall acquire two (2) credits out of four (4) credits required for completion during the semester in which they submit a master's thesis, etc.; and
 - (3) Students shall complete the Academic Language Seminar for the same language other than their native language and shall not take multiple courses in the same semester in principle.
- 3 With the approval of the main academic supervisor and the class instructor, students may replace the elective courses of undergraduate schools (excluding Research Seminar) and "Regional Languages A III" (excluding the native language), "Language of the World" (excluding the native language), "Language and Communication," and "Japan in the World" among the courses offered by the Global Liberal Arts Program with the Major Related courses. However, the maximum number of credits which students who belong to the Global Studies can replace shall be eight (8) credits, and that which students who belong to the Japan Studies can replace shall be ten (10) credits.
- 4 The credits prescribed in Articles 21, 29, and 29-2 of the Graduate School Regulations shall be deemed to have been acquired in the Graduate School and up to ten (10) of such credits may be included in the credits prescribed in Article 28 of the Graduate School Regulations.

Article 4 Change of Course of Study in Master's Programs

Only students who belong to the Global Studies may change their course of study if the Dean of the Graduate School of Global Studies deems it useful for educational research.

Article 5 Courses Offered and Number of Credits in the Doctoral Program of Graduate School

The courses offered and the number of credits assigned to each course in the Doctoral Program of Graduate School shall be as listed in Appendices 8 through 11.

Article 6 Number of Credits Required to Complete the Doctoral Program

The registration procedures for the Doctoral Program of the Graduate School prescribed in Article 28 of the Graduate School Regulations shall be as follows. Students shall acquire the prescribed number of credits and receive research guidance.

(1) Global Studies, Japan Studies

Students shall acquire twelve (12) credits or more from the courses offered for the major they enroll in. However, four (4) credits for the courses prescribed in Appended Table 8 and four (4) credits for the courses offered for the major other than those they enroll in may be included in the twelve (12) credits.

(2) Joint Doctoral Program for Sustainability Research Students shall acquire sixteen (16) credits or more from the courses prescribed in Appended Table 11.
