Tests : Clinical examination, Height, Weight, Vision, Hearing, Urinary test (for protein and sugar level) Chest X-ray, Blood pressure, Blood test (for liver function, anemia test, white cell level, etc.) (JLC Students who started in April only need to attend the clinical examination and blood test)

Note

- 1 If you are pregnant or think you might be, please do not take the Chest X-ray.
 - ② On the day of the checkup, take a morning urine sample on the collection receptacle that has been handed to you in advance.
 - ③ You can take the urine test even if you are having your monthly period.
 - ④ On the day of the checkup, please wear a T-shirt or light sweater without any buttons or clasps. Please avoid wearing a one-piece dress.
 - (5) For those with long hair, please bring a rubber band to tie your hair back.
 - (6) You will be required to remove your brassiere and necklace during the Chest X-ray.
 - O Please do not carry any valuables with you.

Pulmonary tuberculosis is on the rise again recently, and occurs more commonly among people at your age. This medical checkup is a good opportunity for you to get your health checked. The certificate of health will also be issued based on the result of the examination, so please be sure to attend the checkup.

The certificate of health is an important document and we will only issue the certificate to students who have taken part in the checkup. They can be issued within a year of attending the examination.

The certificate of health is necessary for job hunting, so we highly recommend that you take the examination.

If you do not attend the medical checkup, we will not issue the certificate of health to you.
