Announcement: 2023 Spring Health Checkup

Tokyo University of Foreign Studies Health Care Center

The spring periodic health checkup for 2023 will be conducted as follows. All students are required to take this checkup.

(If you do not take the medical examination, you will not be issued a health certificate during the academic year.)

Those who have not had a medical checkup in 2022 are required to undergo one.

All Undergraduate Graduate Research Students other than NEWLY ENROLLED STUDENTS

*Students on leave of absence may also take the medical examination.

However, this does not apply to Credit-course Students.

Place Health Care Center

Test Contents: Self-recognition symptoms, height, weight, vision, hearing, urine (sugar and protein), and blood pressure (chest X-ray is also available if desired)

- ① Collect early morning urine (first urine upon waking up and before eating) in the urine sample container in the health checkup packet that you received
- in advance and bring it with you on the day of the checkup.

Things to ② Health Checkup Form (Please fill in the required information in the bold frame in advance.)

Bring 3 If you wear glasses or contacts, be sure to wear or bring them with you. (If you wear glasses or contacts,

(If you wear glasses or contacts, only your corrected vision will be measured.)

(A) Ballpoint pens (not available for lending due to infection prevention)

NOTES: ① Health checkup packet (health checkup form and urine sample container) will be available from March 22 (Wed.) to April 7 (Fr.), so please come to the Health Care Center to pick one

up. Urine samples must be collected on the morning of the checkup, so please be sure to pick it up at least one day before the checkup.

② Chest X-rays are taken only at the time of admission. It is not necessary to undergo another one during the school year unless there is a special need. However, students who have not had a physical examination at the time of admission are advised to have a chest x-ray. If there are comments in the findings section of the chest x-ray, a follow-up chest x-ray will need to be taken. No appointment is required. Chest X-rays will also be taken if needed for caregiver experience training, educational training, job search, study abroad, etc.

OWaiting time may be long, so be sure to arrive at the reception with enough time.

ONo medical gowns are provided for chest X-ray.

Wear or bring your own plain, thin undershirt, T-shirt, etc.

If you forget to bring one, you will not be able to have an x-ray taken.

(Note that you will not be able to take an X-ray if you do not bring your own T-shirt).

The entificate, which is required in various situations, is issued only for those who have undergone the checkup, and only for one year (within the school year) after the checkup. Please make sure to have a regular medical checkup every year while you are a student.

Oif the schedule is changed due to the status of COVID-19 infection, information will be posted on the Health Care Center's homepage. Please check the latest information by yourself.



7 Requests for Prevention of COVID-19 Transmission

IMPORTANT: Please read this carefully!

As an institution that conducts health checkup, we will implementappropriate countermeasures against infectious diseases and to avoid <code>[3C's]</code> as much as possible to ensure a safe environment for everyone who comes to the site for health examination. Therefore, we would like to ask for your cooperation as follows.

- 1. Those with underlying medical conditions are requested to consult with their attending physician regarding infection prevention measures to be taken during this health checkup. (It has been reported that those with underlying medical conditions such as diabetes, heart failure, respiratory disease, etc., and those undergoing dialysis treatment are at higher risk of severe disease.)
- 2. Please note that you are not allowed to come to the venue if you have any of the following symptoms ① to ⑦ or any of the conditions listed in ⑧ to ⑨ below within 7 days from the day of the event. 【※Please notify the person in charge at your workplace if this applies to you】
 - ① Cold symptoms (nasal discharge, nasal congestion, headache, joint or muscle pain) that persist
 - ② Fever of 37.5°C or higher, or a body temperature higher than normal.
 - 3 Cough or sore throat
 - 4 Respiratory distress or difficulty in breathing
 - ⑤ Fatigue
 - 6 Abnormality of sense of taste or sense of smelling
 - 7 Diarrhea, nausea, vomiting
 - ® Close contact with COVID-19 patient or person having suspicion of COVID-19 (Quarantine period, including self-quarantine)
 - Those who have traveled to countries designated by the Ministry of Justice as countries that require travel restrictions, and those who have a history of contact with such persons
- 3. Please be sure to measure your <u>body temperature</u> at home before coming to the medical checkup site. [We will check your physical condition (temperature, symptoms, etc.) at the reception desk. You may be asked to take your temperature on site.]
- 4. Please bring your own non-woven mask and wear it during the checkup.
- 5. Medical checkup tools are sterilized each time, but please <u>disinfect your hands</u> before you come to the reception desk. [Washing hands with soap and running water for at least 30 seconds is also acceptable.]
- 6. At the medical checkup site
 - We will make sure that there is enough space between examinees, so please <u>allow 1.5 to 2 meters</u> <u>between each other.</u>
 - Minimize conversations and avoid talking too loudly.
 - The venue will be ventilated as much as possible, so please bring something to wear in case of cold weather.
- 7. Medical gowns are not provided for X-ray examinations. Please <u>wear or bring your own plain, thin</u>

 T-shirt, etc. If you forget to bring your own, you cannot take the X-ray examination.
