2025 Health Checkup for International Students will be held as follows. Make sure to take this medical checkup (Reservations are required).

Health checkup for international students is by appointment.

Please make a reservation at the Student Exchange Division between Monday, September 22 and Tuesday, September 30.

Note: Reservations cannot be made at the Health Care Center.

ELIGIBILITY: International students and research students enrolled in Fall 2025

Those who have not undergone Spring 2025 annual health check-up

*However, this does not apply to students enrolled in credit-courses (special register).

VENUE: Health Care Center

TESTS: Self-perceived symptoms, height, weight, vision, hearing, urine (sugar and protein), and

blood pressure (chest X-ray is also available if desired)

WHAT TO BRING:

- ① Collect early morning urine (first urine upon waking up and before eating) in a container that is included in the medical checkup kit you received in advance, and bring it with you on the day of the checkup.
- ② Medical checkup sheet (Please fill in the required information in the bold frame in advance)
- ③ If you wear glasses or contacts, please be sure to wear or bring them with you.

(For those who wear glasses or contacts, only corrected vision will be measured.)

4 Ballpoint pen

NOTES:

① Please pick up the medical checkup kit (medical checkup sheet and urine sample container) at the Student Exchange Division when you make a reservation.

Urine must be collected on the morning of the day of the checkup, so please be sure to pick it up before the day of the checkup.

② Chest X-rays are taken only at the time of admission. Unless there is a special need, chest X-ray is not necessary to be conducted as part of the physical checkup during the student's period of study.

However, those who have not yet taken the medical checkup at the time of admission should have a chest X-ray taken.

Chest X-rays can also be taken when necessary for caregiver experience training, educational training, job hunting, study abroad, etc.

3 Do not bring valuables (precious jewelries, expensive bags, etc.)

(And keep your wallet with you all the time.)

4 Precautions for each test

<URINE TEST>

*You can take the test even during menstruation.

<CHEST X-RAY>

*Do not take this test if you are or might be pregnant.

*No jewelry or bras may be worn.

*If you have long hair, please bring an elastic band to tie it up.

*Medical gowns are not provided for the X-ray examination.

Please be sure to wear or bring your own plain, thin undershirt, T-shirt, etc.

If you forget to bring your own, you will not be able to take the X-ray examination. (Please note that you will not be able to take an X-ray without a plain tee.)

XPlease fill out the medical checkup form by yourself.

(To prevent infection, we will not lend out pens and pencils.)

*Health certificates, which are required in various situations, will be issued only to those who have taken the examination and only within the current academic year (six months) after the examination. Please be sure to have a regular health checkup every year while you are studying.

Measures for preventing infectious diseases



Please read the following important information

We appreciate your cooperation during the health checkup.

- 1. Please note that if you have a temperature of 37.5°C or higher or are suffering from an infectious disease (coronavirus, influenza, etc.) on the day, you will not be able to undergo the health checkup.
- 2. Please be sure to measure your temperature at home before coming to the health checkup on the day.
 - You may be asked to take your temperature at the Health Care Center.
- 3. We recommend that you bring your own mask (non-woven mask) and wear it during the health checkup.
- 4. Inside the TUFS Health Care Center, we ask for your cooperation in maintaining social distance between participants in the health check up.
 - Please keep conversations to a minimum. Please do not speak loudly.
 - The TUFS Health Care Center will be ventilated and the number of people will be limited, so you may have to wait outside for a long time. Please bring something warm to wear if it's cold outside.
- 5. If you are undergoing an X-ray examination, please bring or wear plain, thin undergarments or T-shirts.
