1. Position: Part-time English language lecturer

From April 2024 to March 2025 (renewable)

4. Duties and Responsibilities:

- Teaching one or more of the following English language courses: Interactive English (communication-based English courses for 1st year students and above), Academic English: Skill-based (skill-based English courses for 2nd year students and above), Career English (courses for 3rd year students and above to develop skills for international business communication), English language courses for English majors, English for Academic Purposes (courses for graduate students with advanced-level (CEFR C1/C2) of English proficiency)
- Teaching one or more of the lecture courses if the candidate is qualified.
