

## Regarding course registration for the Summer Quarter in AY2025

Attn: All undergraduate students, graduate students,

Be sure to register for all the courses through the Academic Affairs System by yourself.

[Registration period / Registration amendment period]

From 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, July 9 to 4:59 p.m., Friday, July 11, 2025

Note: The registration period and the registration amendment period for the Summer Quarter Courses take place in the same period.

Regarding course registration cancellation

Note that if you wish to cancel your registration, you are required to cancel by 5:00 p.m. on the day before the class (delivery) starts. (If the previous day of the class falls on a weekend or holiday, cancel by 5:00 p.m. on the previous weekday.)

For cancellation, submit an "Application form for course registration amendment" to the Educational Affairs Division (Kyoumu-ka Kiroku-kakari) or send the form by email to [kiroku@tufs.ac.jp](mailto:kiroku@tufs.ac.jp). Please note that you may only cancel courses held in the Summer Quarter. The number of credits which were canceled will not be counted towards "the 50-credit limit per year rule."

1. When registering, you will need an account to log in to the Academic Affairs System and a password to log in to your ICC account. Please check in advance if you can log in to the Academic Affairs System without any problems.
2. Students who do not complete the procedures within the above mentioned period will not be allowed to register for courses for the Summer Quarter in AY2025. Students who wish to take courses must complete the necessary procedures.
3. As for language courses, Major Language Courses, GLIP English Intensive Courses, and Regional Language Courses are offered in the Summer Quarter.

<b>Procedure</b>	Register through the Academic Affairs System
<b>Registration period</b>	From 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, July 9 to 4:59 p.m., Friday, July 11, 2025
<b>Notes</b>	<p>Each class is limited in capacity, and registration is on a first-come, first-served basis. Once the class is full, you will not be able to register for the course.</p> <p>“English B1” taught by Prof. O’Donnell and Prof. Koizumi Yuko: The capacity is 24 for students entering TUFS in and after 2019, and 1 for students entering TUFS before 2019.</p> <p>“English B1” taught by Prof. Cannell and Prof. Field: The capacity is 24 for students entering TUFS in and after 2019, and 1 for students entering TUFS before 2019.</p> <p>“English B1” taught by Prof. Shewack: The capacity is 46 for students entering TUFS in and after 2019, and 4 for students entering TUFS before 2019.</p> <p>“English B1” taught by Prof. Pipe: The capacity is 46 for students entering TUFS in and after 2019, and 4 for students entering TUFS before 2019.</p> <p>* Note that students are required to attend all lessons of the course.</p> <p>* Note that students are not allowed to take the same class again with the same content taught by the same instructor for which credits have been earned in the past.</p> <p>* For those who wish to take English B1 (Online and On-Demand) courses taught by Prof. Shewack or Prof. Pipe, make sure to check <a href="#">the attached information</a> in advance as there are some precautions upon course registration.
