



# Peace and Conflict On-Demand Course Package

## Guidance for Participants

This series of lectures which aims to cultivate peacebuilding professionals, is an on-demand class offered through the Japan Virtual Campus (JV-Campus) platform. In addition to course registration, you need to register for a JV-Campus account. Here is an explanation about the courses offered and how to access the lectures.

### Available Courses

Each course consists of 15 lectures, which are 45 minutes long (3 videos of 15 minutes each). A quiz is required after each video, and a short test or assignment must be submitted for each lesson. 1 credit can be earned per course. The following list shows the course title, Class code (8-digit number) and [Course Name] for the applicable subjects.

You do not need to take all courses in the package. (You may take a single course.)

Each of the six courses is offered twice a year. As the course content remains unchanged, students are advised not to enroll in the same course more than once.
