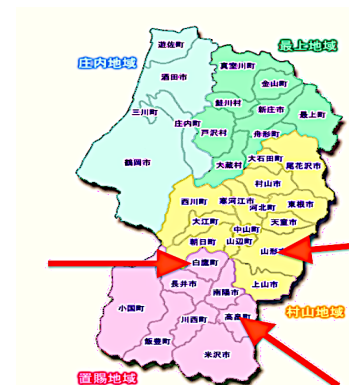

During the “Study Tour” held during the summer quarter, international and Japanese students stay together in Yamagata to experience local history, culture, and industry. See it with your own eyes, experience it firsthand, and with the local people, tackle with the challenges the local and Japanese societies face. This year’s “Study Tour” is scheduled as a half-day of preparatory session in the afternoon on July 31(Fri) and about 4 days in early September to participate in local activities in Yamagata (expected during intensive E period), followed by the debriefing session on Sept. 24 (Thur). (The expense will be explained at the guidance) Students will join the local events, visit the local farmers, exchange with local people, and provide advice to local municipalities based on the surveys conducted.
