## Regarding the course registration for the Winter Quarter, AY2022

Make sure to register for all the courses through the Academic Affairs System by yourself.

Note: The registration period and the registration amendment period for the Winter Quarter Courses take place in the same period.

Regarding course registration cancelation

Note that if you wish to cancel a course held in the Winter Quarter, you are required to cancel by 5:00 p.m. on the day before the class (delivery) starts. (If the previous day of the class falls on a weekend or holiday, cancel by 5:00 p.m. on the previous weekday.)

For cancellation, submit an "Application form for course registration amendment" to the Educational Affairs Division (Kyoumu-ka Kiroku-kakari) or send the form by email to <a href="kiroku@tufs.ac.jp">kiroku@tufs.ac.jp</a>. Please note that you may only cancel courses held in the Winter Quarter. The number of credits which were canceled will not be counted towards "the 50-credit limit per year rule."

- 1. When registering, you will need an account to log in to the Academic Affairs System and a password to log in to your ICC account. Please check in advance if you can log in to the Academic Affairs System without any problems.
- Students who do not complete the procedures within the above mentioned period will not be allowed to register for courses in the Winter Quarter in AY2022. Students who wish to take courses must complete the necessary procedures.
- 3. As for language courses, Major Language Courses, GLIP English Intensive Courses, and Regional Language Courses are offered in the Winter Quarter.
- 4. If you are a graduate student in the Doctoral Program, please make sure to use the course codes which are set depending on the year you entered TUFS; the 8-digit course codes including an alphabetical letter are for students who entered TUFS before 2017, while the 6-digit course codes are for the students who entered TUFS in and after 2018. Please confirm carefully before course registration to avoid any mistakes. Mistakes in registration codes will result in not meeting the completion requirements for graduation.
