Dr. Lucija Čevnik: The Body as a Social Phenomenon: Beauty Practices and

Body Ideals Among Young People in Slovenia

This lecture explores the body as a social construct shaped by cultural norms, beauty

standards, gender expectations, and age-specific pressures within a national context. We will

examine how the body is perceived, constructed, and regulated from early childhood

through adolescence, young adulthood, and into later life — with particular attention to the

different ways male and female bodies are socially framed and treated.

Focusing on the Slovenian context, the lecture will analyze how social influences – including

media, tradition, and institutional norms – impact young people's bodily self-understanding

and identity, while also considering how age plays a crucial role in shaping bodily

expectations and ideals.

Dr. Lucija Čevnik is a sociologist, professor, author, publicist, and counselor. Her academic and

public work centers on body image, the influence of media and cultural narratives on youth,

and the social construction of the body across different life stages. Her approach combines

critical sociological insight with deep empathy and commitment to the lived realities of

individuals in a rapidly changing society.
